## Look at our Dentists

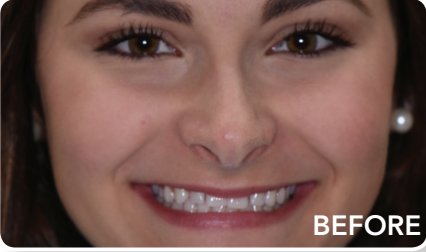
### FEATURED CASE: Dr. Lara Bacchelli

Within two weeks, I had received the wax up back from the lab and Dr. Barrett and I were ready to get started. Very conservative preparations were done which did wrap around to the lingual to facilitate easier seating of the case. It was easy to see once



the temporaries were in place, that at rest, Taylor's display greatly improved. Two weeks later, the case was completed and the final veneers were bonded into place. What makes this case so rewarding is the fact that Taylor, at 17 years old, saved her own money from working a part time job to help pay for her veneers. The entire team was just thrilled when we saw Taylor's smile at her final photo appointment. 📷

### PATIENT PERSPECTIVE TAYLOR DESTASIO – PATIENT IN ABOVE CASE

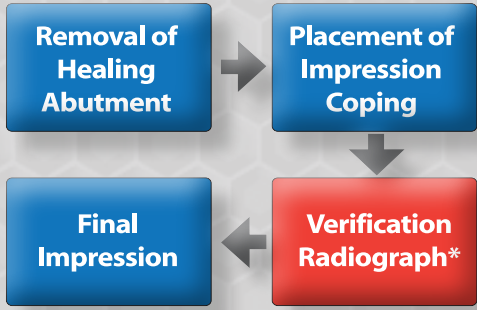

### Insights From Some of Our In-House Specialty Support

#### FINAL IMPRESSION FOR IMPLANT CROWN RESTORATIONS

When compared to conventional crown and bridge, implant dentistry has the advantage of being simple, predictable and cost-effective. During the final impression appointment following a simple algorithm can provide the clinician with predictable treatment outcomes:

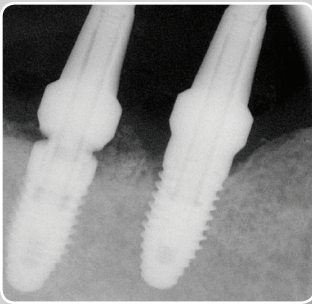
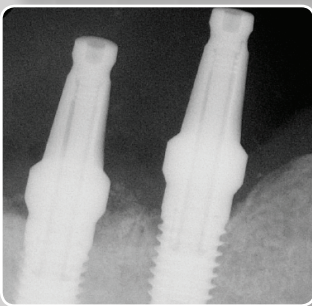


Figure 2: Once impression coping was repositioned, a second radiograph was taken, revealing properly seated impression coping

The single most important step\* during this visit is taking the time to take a radiograph to verify proper and complete seating of the impression coping. By taking a radiograph of the implant and impression coping once it has been seated and hand torqued intra-orally, and prior to making the final impression, the clinician can verify complete seating of the component. This will appear radiographically as lack of radiolucency between the implant and coping (Fig. 2).

Figure 1: Radiograph reveals improperly seated impression coping

This simple and easy step in the restorative dentist's routine when restoring single or multiple implants can avoid inaccuracies in the placement of this component and final impression that could result in ill-fitting restorations, and will surely help decrease costly remakes. 📷
